Frame Types

Type I (TI) - Ember Protection

Designed for use with gas, coal or pellet units (not to be used with wood units). R-Value <1.0.

1" Heavy-Duty Frame

- Automotive-quality painting process

1/2" Non-Combustible Substrate

- No flame spreading or smoke development, per ASTM E84, E126 standards
- Rugged Dragonboard material provides maximum flooring protection
- Mold-resistant



Type I Frame Edge Detail

Type II (TII) - Ember and Thermal Protection

Designed for use with wood, gas, coal or pellet units.

R-Value 1.59

1-1/2" Aluminum Extruded T-Shaped Frame

- Ultimate protection: 1.08 thermal resistance (R-Value)
- Automotive-quality painting process

Construction

- Above internal T frame:
 - Same as Type I Ember Shield
- Below internal T frame:
 - Non-intrusive, contoured aluminum black frame
 - 1/2" mineral fiber board installed to within inches of frame
 - Offers maximum support under stove
 - Does not rely on air pocket for thermal value
 - Provides best possible thermal protection available in 1-1/2" frame



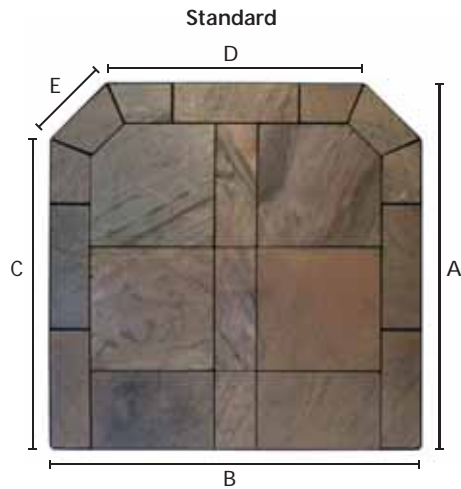
Type II Frame Edge Detail



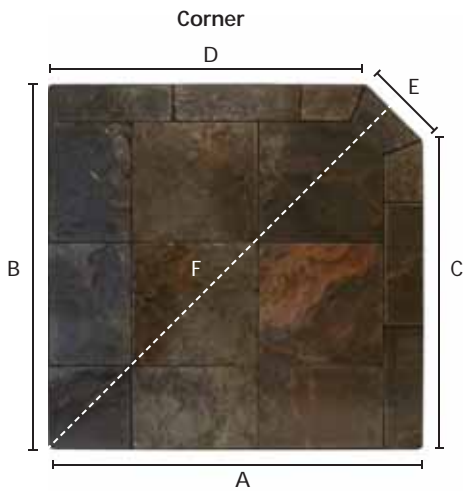
Type II Frame Cut Away

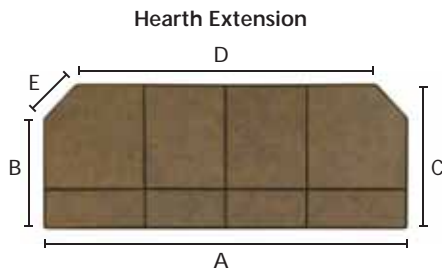
